

Florida Rep adheres to a media release policy to streamline approval process for media associated with each production. Parking

Parking is available in the lot across from the theatre on Bay Street. Parking is free but you will need a fob to open the gate. If you are housed downtown and have driven your own car you should have received a fob from Company Management. If you are not provided a fob or there is not a fob in the company car one is available at the Box Office to borrow.

Rehearsal Spaces

• <u>East Rehearsal Hall</u>: Is located down the street at our Old Office Bldg., at the corners of Bay/Lee and Lee/First Streets. The doors on Bay Street and Lee Street entrances are unlocked Monday through Friday 9a-5p. Take the elevator or stairs to the 2nd floor. The Bay Street entrance is at the end of the build (pass the building with the painted clouds), there is a stoop to the entrance. The Lee St entrance is in a courtyard, look for the double doors to the right. There will be a member of the Florida Rep Staff posted outside to let you in the building!

Smoking

There is absolutely no smoking allowed inside the theatre, offices, rehearsal spaces or any of the public spaces. This includes e-cigarettes and vape pens. Smoking is permitted outside away from entrances.

General Rehearsal Information

- 1. Schedule: Rehearsals are Tuesday-Friday, 5:30pm-9:00pm, and Saturday 10:00am-1:00pm. Stage Management will send out a rehearsal calendar every Saturday with the schedule for the upcoming week, so please reference that if you have questions about when you are called! Stage Management will also have a Daily Call posted in the rehearsal room that will list in detail what is being worked on, when and where, etc. for each rehearsal day.
- 2. Rehearsal Arrival: Please do not arrive to rehearsal before 5:10pm. This gives my team and I the time to get everything ready and set up for you all. That being said, please do your best to arrive before 5:25pm. If you have not arrived by then, you will receive a call from Stage Management (either myself or Catalina). I have listed both of our numbers below. PARENTS:PLEASE SAVE THEM!
- 3. Lateness: If you believe you are going to be late, please text Stage Management via Remind101 BEFORE 5:25PM and let us know that you will be late and when you believe you will arrive. Please be ready to work by 5:30pm. This means focused and tuned into the space. We are going to get right to work when rehearsals start! Please understand that lateness has a profound effect on the beginning of rehearsal. The shuffling and scattered energy that comes with being late should be left at the door. We take it as a matter of trust that if you are late, it is for a very, VERY good reason. Please do not disrupt rehearsal by explaining yourself. Basically, don't be late!
- **4. Rehearsal Absence:** Please do not come to rehearsal if you are contagious or not feeling well. We will discuss this more in person. That being said, if you are not feeling well, please contact us BEFORE rehearsal via Remind101 to let us know you will not be in rehearsal. If you miss classes because you are not feeling well, please do not try to tough it out for rehearsal.
 - **5. Signing In**: Once you have arrived at rehearsal, you will sign-in on the wall nearest to the door (both in East Rehearsal Hall and the Education Office). Stage Management will point out both of these locations!
- **6. Rehearsal Attire:** Please come in clothes you are comfortable in AND can easily move in EVERY DAY! Also, bring layers as the rehearsal rooms can be cold and we want you to keep your bodies and muscles warmer than you think you need in order to avoid muscle pulls and tears.
 - 7. **Technology/Homework during rehearsals:** As this show requires a lot of moving parts and keen attention to detail, we are asking that all phones/smartwatches/any other distracting devices be put away and silenced during rehearsals. If there is a long gap of time in between your scenes, you may move to the side of the rehearsal room and work on homework silently; but, please be ready to work at any time!
- **8. Materials:** Please make sure you have a pencil, water, and your scripts with you every day. You will receive your scripts during rehearsal. These are yours to use during our process, but **please make sure you take care of your script!** It is a

very important part of our process and you will need it every day! I will also have my kit with me at all times. I have everything from pencils to band aids, etc.I am happy to share my supplies, but they are expected to be returned to me at the end of every rehearsal unless it is a consumable product.

- 1. Please come in and start getting ready. Wigs, Hair, Makeup, Mics and Costumes!
- 2. All fight/lift/safety and intimacy calls will begin 1 hour and 15 minutes before GO (6:45pm Opening Night, 5:45pm Fri/Sat Shows, and 12:45pm Sunday Shows). You MUST be in costumes for this!
- 3. After Safety Calls are complete, Miss Emily will do a vocal warm up on stage! I will announce this to you, so you know when it is!
- 4. **MY TIME CALLS ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT!** I know the speaker levels are low, but you need to hear when I call things! Please keep an ear out for my voice!
 - a. You will get a half hour/house open, a 15 min to places, 5 to places, and places call.
- 5. ONCE 15 TO PLACES IS CALLED, PHONES MUST GO AWAY! This is time for you to get your head in the show and prepare yourself for the run! PLEASE USE IT!
- 6. Just a reminder: You MUST stay quiet when you are in the dressing room area. We have another show happening just down the hall from you!
- **7.** NO FOOD IN THE DRESSING ROOMS! You can keep your food in the green room (the first room you walk into when you are heading backstage)!

- 1. Thank you for coming!

- 2. Miranda sent pictures of the set to Nick.
- 3. Shop window cannot be made bigger at this point.
- 4. Is there a shelf unit/bookshelf that can be added to the upstage-most wall?
 - a. That is the plan!
 - i. Broken-down during pre-renovation period.
 - ii. Pretty and new post-renovation.
- 5. Question from Monique: Is the fourth wall of the flower shop imagined more as a window or as a solid wall?
 - a. It can be a window! Whatever works for the telling of the story!
- 6. Can we get a new set rendering with the dentist platform or pictures of it?
 - a. Charles will send Paul (Lights) pictures of the Dentist platform in relation to the booms for Paul to review.

Paints

- 1. List of load-in notes that will be able to be addressed next week after *Beguiled Again* load-in is complete!
- 2. Paint elevations are in SharePoint for Monique to review!

Properties

- 1. We got some rehearsal props in yesterday! Thank you!!!
- 2. Props and director are in discussion about prop updates.

- 3. Props needs direction and blocking to get started on tentacles placement for Audrey II.
 - a. We should be able to start blocking that movement next week.
 - i. We just started blocking yesterday (Tuesday, Sept 5th) and stopped after "Grow For Me" (Act 1, Scene 1).
 - ii. We are hoping to get most of Act 1 done by the end of the week!
 - b. Monique can be in space for details about tentacle placement whenever is convenient for the shop!
- 4. Do we have a cart that can be decorated like a portable flower cart for "Chinese Man" Scene?
 - a. There are a couple of options in the shop. Jesseca will send pictures of them over to Monique.
- 5. Does Monique want an advertising sign for Audrey II that says something like "Here She Is"?
 - a. Yes, she does!
 - b. We will have to decide where it sits (on the plant or next to the plant?)
- 6. Do we have a bell attachment that will ring when the flower shop door (downstage left door) is opened?
 - a. Yes, props has one!

Costumes

- 1. We have 15 belt packs that will be needed for mics
 - a. If there are any extra pouches, that would be great!
- 2. Who will be wigged/will wear a headpiece throughout the show?
 - a. Audrey, & Do-oop girls will be wigged. Audrey II will wear a hat on top of a wig cap for her ensemble role in the "Prologue/Little Shop of Horrors" and "Skid Row"; she will wear a headpiece for Audrey II.
- 3. What is Lyla (cast as Audrey II) wearing for her ensemble track in the "Prologue/Little Shop of Horrors" and "Skid Row"?
 - a. In Skid Row she will be a homeless person, and we would like for her to be as unrecognizable as possible.
 - i. Loose-fitting clothing, etc.
- 4. Costumes does not have brown oxfords in storage for the actor playing Mushnik, as he wears a size 13.
- 5. Ben will send over some shoe options through links on Amazon and the shop will order them through our Amazon account, as we already have tax exempt forms on our account.
- 6. The promo shoot is tonight (Wednesday, Sept 6th).
 - a. Good place costume-wise.
 - b. Sam can send pictures over to Ben for this.
- 7. Costume discovery from Rehearsal on 09/06/2023

- a. Chinese Man Scene in "Grow For Me"
- b. Can the girls be in the traditional-style dresses (tighter fitting)?
 - i. The girls will have time to make those changes
 - 1. Costumes will look for these dresses in storage, & Ben will do some online research
- c. Chinese Man: Tang Jacket and Eastern/Western Fusion.
 - i. The Chinese Man will be Ethan Mohring
- 8. What style of Gas Mask are we looking at for Orin?
 - a. Monique would like to see the options that we have.
 - b. The mask needs to be something that covers the mouth/face, with some style of attachment.
 - c. Props will be over to look at the Freud Mask soon.
 - i. Monique would prefer for the mask to not be removed by the actor during the scene, as it breaks the idea of asphyxiation.
 - d. Emily would prefer just the outer-rim of a mask, so the actor can breathe properly and the actor can be seen.
 - i. Maybe bottom can be cut out of the mask?
 - ii. How will the mask affect sound?
 - 1. Orin could be mic-ed on his Forehead (Crown) to help avoid the echo chamber in the mask.
 - e. We will play with this during Sound Tech

Lights

- 1. Could we get a new set rendering with Dentist Platform to reference its location to the booms?
 - a. Reference scenic note 6.
- 2. Concept video from Monique of possible direction for effects on the curtain for the top of the show.
 - a. Based on equipment inventory, we will not be able to recreate anything along the lines of the video sent over by Monique.
 - i. Paul is free to come up with something eerie and alien-like for opening.
- 3. Vignette/Tableau section for Scene 1 on pg.21(MTI script).
 - a. This is just before Mushnik says he's going to close the shop. This is the dialogue directly following #2A.
 - b. Can we fully black out and bring the lights back 3 times to establish time and show 3 small vignettes in different positions.
 - i. Full black out (audience will not see the actors shift)
- 4. Can the lighting shift after "Grow For Me" to focus down on Audrey II after Seymour "flicks off" the lights in the shop. This is just before the music swells and Audrey II grows.

- a. Paul says this is totally doable!
- 5. Marissa will get back to Paul and Emma on scheduling for Paper Tech!

Sound

- 1. Emma now has access to updated MTI login for performance tracks.
- 2. The Cast list is 18, but we only have 15 microphones.
 - a. Emily will get back to Emma on who she would like to be mic-ed.
- 3. Can there be a clock chime for the small vignette scene on pg. 21?
 - a. Yes!
- 4. Doorbell for door opening?
 - a. Reference props note 6.
- 5. We will not have an A2, as the sound intern, Braden, will be on *Beguiled Again*.
- 6. Can we use a handheld practical for the DJ scene?
 - a. Wireless handhelds are on a separate system from the wireless body mics.
 - i. Do we have the 60's style mics?
 - 1. There should be at least one that is not in use for *Beguiled Again*.
 - 2. Monique does not want a 21st century mic, so the mic will have to be wired.
 - b. Mic will have to be carried on and carried off with cable management.
 - i. We will need a stagehand.
 - 1. ASM, Catalina, and a production swing will be backstage.
 - 2. Monique is also okay to assign an actor to cable management.
 - c. Is there a courtyard event that overlaps?
 - i. Not that we are currently aware of!
- 7. The Little Shop music tracks have a lot of built-in fermatas.
 - a. Stage Management is calling the music tracks and placement of these cues will be worked out with actors in rehearsals.
- 8. Marissa will get back to Paul and Emma about when she wants to paper tech.
- 9. Who do we have in Head pieces and Wigs for sound?
 - a. Reference costume note 2.a.
